- Awarded each semester (maximum of two terms per student only. After initial first award, a student must re-apply to be considered for a second and final award contingent upon that student obtaining and maintaining 2.75 GPA. during the first award period)

Academic Requirements:

- Upon acceptance of scholarship, student must achieve and maintain at least a 2.75 GPA.
- Student must be able to assess with the following scores:

Writing- 15 or above	Writing-76 or above
Reading- 17 or above	Reading-78 or above
Mathematics-16 or above	Mathmatics-76 or above

- Student must be pursuing technical trades certificates of proficiency, technical certificates that follow the educational pathway that potentially leads towards the degree AAS: General Technology/Industrial Electricity &Technology
- Student must be an incoming freshman (can have secondary/concurrent college hours) or 1st time entering student
- Funds will be used to pay towards books, fees, tuition.
- After account is paid in full, per semester, any unused RAMP scholarship funds will be returned to the RAMP Grant Program
- Payment of the scholarship will be directly applied to account thru the business office
